Class 3. BRC Novice Individual Qualifier (fences 2'6 - 2'9)

Class 4. BRC Open Individual Qualifier (fences 2'9 - 3'0)

Class 5. BRC Novice Pairs Qualifier (fences 2'6 – 2'9 incl. dressing fence)

(New format 7–10 show jumps followed straight after by 8–15 x-country jumping efforts)

It is the responsibility of the Club to check their member's eligibility.

Breach of rules will disqualify team. – Open Team & Individuals will run first.

Conditions

1. Horses must be 4 years old or over for all classes.
2. After three refusals at any one fence you must immediately leave the course at walk.
3. Any horse competing in more than one class must compete HC in the second class. Except the pairs competition. For all classes skull caps/hats must be worn to **minimum standard EN1384 or PAS015, body protectors and medical armbands and number bibs are compulsory.**
4. The course may be walked from 2.00pm on Saturday 27th March 2010.
5. Neither Titwood Equestrian nor Ayr Riding Club accept any responsibility for accident, injury or damage to any horse, rider, spectator or property whatsoever.
6. Entries not paid by closing date will be charged double the fees.
7. 50% of entry fees will be refunded (on receipt of a SAE) if the event is cancelled.
8. **Entries for qualifying classes must be on Official Entry Forms.**
9. **Each BRC club entering classes must provide helpers on the day of the event – these helpers must be nominated by 15th March 2010.**
10. **Classes 6, 7 & 8, non qualifying entries on from below – PLEASE NOTE THESE CLASSES WILL FOLLOW THE BRC TEAM, INDIVIDUAL & PAIRS QUALIFIERS.**

Entry fees: Individuals £25 per horse (£23 for Ayr Riding Club Members). £90 per BRC team and £40 per BRC pair, non qualifier pairs entries will also be taken on the day. First aid cost included.
