**Class 1 Novice Starter**

For horse and rider combinations who have not been placed 1<sup>st</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup> in any jumping event. Height of fences 60cms and using BD Prelim 10 (2002). Show Jumping speed 325mpm, Cross Country speed 415mpm. *Sponsored by Lyne Farm Bed & Breakfast, Peebles, EH45 8NR, 01721 740255*

**Class 2 Novice**

For horse and rider combinations who have NOT completed a BE Event this year, or won any horse/hunter trials event over 90cms this year. Height of fences 70cms and using dressage test BD Preliminary 14 (2006). Show Jumping speed 325mpm, Cross Country speed 435mpm. *Sponsored by Clyde Veterinary Group, 01555 660000, [www.clydevetgroup.co.uk/](http://www.clydevetgroup.co.uk/)*

**Class 3 Intermediate**

For horse and rider combinations who have NOT gained any British Eventing points or have completed a BE90 event this year. Height of fences 85cms and using dressage test BD Novice 25 (2005). **Class 4 Small Open**

**It is up to YOU to read these rules carefully to avoid disappointment**

### **Arena Event Class Rules**

These classes will run along the lines of British Eventing's Express Eventing which was held at Cardiff's Millenium Stadium in November of 2008. Competitors will each ride a dressage test, have a changeover and rest period, and then complete a show-jumping round which is followed by a "cross country" round. There is a 5-10 minute period between the end of the show jumping for a safety check and breather before coming under starters orders at the cross country. There will not be sufficient time for any tack or dress change between jumping elements therefore competitors should present for both jumping phases in their cross country kit and colours. Cross country fences are of working hunter style and ALL will be knock-down. Each competitor will be given an allocated time to ride their dressage test, and a second time to start their consecutively run jumping elements.

As with British Eventing, dressage tests will be scored in penalties. However, show-jumping and cross-country will be equally weighted with faults scored as below:

Pole Down: 4 faults	Every commenced period of 1 second in excess of the optimum time: 0.4 penalties
First refusal: 5 faults	
Second refusal: 10 faults	
Third refusal: elimination	Every commenced period of 1 second in excess of 15 seconds under the optimum time: 0.4 penalties
Fall of rider: elimination	
Fall of horse: elimination	

With the emphasis on a FUN event for all, competitors *may* be allowed to proceed after a third refusal or after a rider fall, but this will be *entirely* at the judge's discretion and their decision is final.

The lowest cumulative score will win. In the event of a tie, the combination closest to the optimum cross country time will win. In the event of equality on cross country time, the combination with the highest collective dressage marks will win.

### **General Rules**

1. This competition is run under British Riding Club rules except as specified herein.
2. The Judge's decision is final.
3. All competitors must be paid up members of a BHS affiliated Riding Club or Pony Club or the BHS itself.
4. All under 18's must be accompanied by an adult as Peebles & District take no responsibility for any harm that may come to them.
5. A hard hat to EN1384, PAS015:1998, ASTM F1163, BSEN14572:2005 or SEA American standard SNELL E2001, ASTM95, SNZ3838 1998 must be worn and fastened at all times while mounted. Skullcap hats must be worn with a silk. Failure to do so will incur a £10 fine and request to leave the event. **Fixed peaks are NOT permitted for cross country.**
6. **Body protectors** approved to Class 3 (Purple label) **MUST be worn for both jumping phases.** Any persons not adhering to this may be asked to leave the showground.
7. **Medical Armbands are compulsory** for both jumping phases and must be properly completed with the relevant competitor's details.
8. Horses must be 4 years old or over
9. Competitors are expected to be mindful of their horses welfare and fitness when making their entries. The organisers may request the owner of any equine whose welfare gives rise for concern to cease riding the animal and/or remove it from the showground. Any of that animals remaining entries will be forfeit.
10. The organisers reserve the right to combine or split classes according to entries.
11. Entries will be accepted on the official entry form only and must be prepaid.
12. Peebles and District Riding Club, the organisers or the venue owners accept no responsibility for any accident, loss or damage to persons, animals or property whatsoever
13. Objections to be made in writing within one hour of the class with £10 deposit which will be returned if the complaint is upheld
14. No refunds can be given after the closing date.
15. In the event of cancellation, 75% of entry fees will be refunded to those who request it.
16. No competitor may enter more than 2 classes total per horse.
17. Please don't muck out horseboxes onto the showground, a fine of £20 will be issued to anyone caught doing so.
18. Stallions can only be brought to a show with prior notification and permission granted from the entries secretary
19. Competitors are kindly requested to enter into the spirit of the competition and enter classes suited to their ability.
