Competitors that enter this class may not enter any other show jumping class
Combination of pony/horse & rider not to have won a 1st in any S.J. class.
Jumps will not exceed 1'6"" in first round

CLEAR ROUND to follow Class 41

CLEAR ROUND will be available throughout the day at various heights. Entries will be taken on the field at £2 per round.
Rosettes will be awarded to all clear rounds.

RULES and REGULATIONS

1. Show jumping will be run under current BSJA rules.
2. Numbers may be restricted in all classes at the discretion of the organisers. Classes may be split or amalgamated if necessary.
3. Hard hats of the current British Standard (PAS015/EN1384) must be worn at all times while mounted. Failure to comply will result in a fine of £10.
4. Points will be awarded to Strathendrick Riding Club members according to places achieved. The competitor's top three placings will count towards the Strathendrick Rose Bowl, which will be awarded at the Club's AGM to the highest scoring horse/rider combination
5. All trophies are perpetual and remain the property of Strathendrick Riding Club.
6. Trophy winners are responsible for the safe return of the trophy in time for the following year's show.
7. Strathendrick Riding Club and any person helping the Riding Club will not be liable for any loss or damage to any person, animal or vehicle.
8. Everything reasonably practicable is done to ensure the health, safety and welfare of those attending the event.
9. Members of the public and competitors are equally responsible for ensuring that they do not put themselves and/or other persons at risk, and that they co-operate with the organisers in complying with health and safety measures.
10. Any complaint should be made in writing and accompanied by a fee of £20 to the Show Secretary. The fee will be returned if the complaint is upheld.
11. It is the responsibility of the competitors to present themselves at the rings at the correct time. It is inevitable that some clashes will occur and competitors must be prepared to make a choice between classes if necessary.
12. All dogs must be kept on leads.
13. Foul language and/or abuse of horses will not be tolerated and will result in immediate elimination.
14. No refunds will be given after Monday 8th September, 2008.
15. Horses must be ridden at walk outside designated practice areas.
16. Age of rider as on day of show.
17. All Horses and or Ponies in ridden classes **MUST** be 4 years old and over on the day of the show.
18. No horse/pony shall be allowed to enter more than 5 classes.
19. Handlers in classes 4 & 40 must be over 16 years of age.
20. Under 18s should have an adult responsible for them on the show field at all times.
21. Competitors' numbers to be collected from the secretary on the day, from the secretary's tent.

Classes marked as **FESTIVAL OF CHAMPIONS QUALIFIER** are qualifiers for the Festival of Champions Scotland 11th-19th October 2008. Those placed 1st – 4th in the marked classes will receive qualifying cards and will qualify for their respective class at the Festival of Champions Scotland 2008.
